OUT AND ABOUT WITH DAISY & CLAIRE





Rest in Peace Sweet Dora



Dora and her brother, Diego, originally came in to Safe Haven in 2021 as an owner surrender due to a major health issue with their owner. They were with us for over a year, before being adopted in 2022, but eventually they were returned to Safe Haven when the adopter's living situation changed. Their second stay at Safe Haven ended up lasting over a year once again - because understandably, two large 8 yr old Pittie mixes is not exactly what most adopters are looking for. Then, Dora and Diego's original owner's sister (that lives in Oregon!) decided she wanted to find a way to get them out of the shelter, and bring them to Eugene, Oregon! Since she already has a dog, she decided to ask her neighbor/coworker to adopt Dora & Diego. He flew out to Iowa and met the dogs and decided he would be honored to adopt them and be part of their great story, and they can all live "together" in Oregon! Unfortunately, Dora developed an aggressive cancer in her leg, which was amputated. Although the surgeon hoped the sarcoma was contained, a pathology report showed that it had spread to a lymph node and most recently had spread to her kidneys and liver. It was decided not to pursue chemo and radiation which would likely only have extended her life a few months. Instead her days were filled with car rides, sun bathing, hiking, and trips to the ocean, and a visit from her original owner. Of course she was showered with lots and lots of love.


Lyra is doing great! We are calling her Willow. My kids love her and she has settled in wonderfully!






Caring for Community Cats in colder seasons



1. Provide shelter (or feeding station) such as a barn, outdoor feral cat house (can be found on Amazon) or a DIY shelter insulated with Styrofoam or straw. Be sure to avoid using blankets or hay.
2. Provide food and water. Extreme cold weather can increase a cat's energy and nutritional needs.
3. Check your car before driving. Before driving, check under the hood of your car. Animals, including cats and kittens, sometimes climb up underneath cars or inside engines to seek warmth
