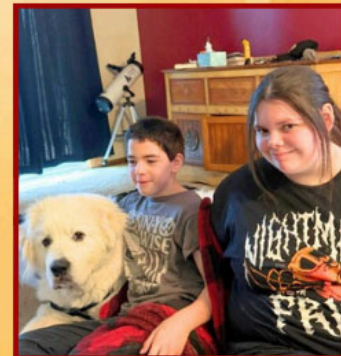
Sabrina (now Lulu) is having the most fun with her new "sibling" - a full grown lab. They stalk each other around the house. Hilarious!

# Itty Bitty Kitty Fosters Needed.



Safe haven is currently looking for volunteers to provide foster care for kittens that need to be bottle fed. We will provide individual training and all the needed supplies.

Becoming a kitten foster involves providing a safe and nurturing environment for kittens to grow and thrive until they are ready for adoption, requiring a time commitment for feeding, cleaning, socialization, and potentially medical care. Lots of support will be provided by our experienced fosters.

## **Key Considerations for Kitten Fostering:**

### **Time Commitment:**

- Fostering requires a significant daily time commitment, particularly for very young kittens who need frequent feeding (every 2-4 hours), stimulation to eliminate, and supervision.

### **Space:**

- Designate a safe, warm, and draft-free area for your foster kittens, such as a spare room, bathroom, or a large enclosure like a crate or large dog carrier. This area should be easy to clean.

### **Socialization and Training:**

- Foster parents are responsible for socializing the kittens, helping them learn to use the litter box, and becoming comfortable with handling and various household noises.

### **Medical Care:**

- You may need to administer medications.
- You will need to transport kittens to Safe Haven for check-ups, vaccinations, and spay/neuter procedures.

### **Patience and Emotional Preparedness:**

- Kitten fostering is a rewarding but demanding experience, requiring patience and emotional preparedness for the challenges and the eventual goodbye when the kittens go to Safe Haven to be adopted into permanent homes.
